Thomas P. Leist, MD, PhD, is Professor of Neurology, Chief of the Division of Clinical Neuroimmunology, and Director of the Comprehensive Multiple Sclerosis (MS) Center at Jefferson University in Philadelphia, PA. He also directs the Jefferson Medical College fellowship program in clinical neuroimmunology. Dr. Leist earned a PhD from the University of Zurich in Switzerland and received his medical degree from the University of Miami School of Medicine. He completed his residency at Cornell Medical Center and Memorial

Sloan-Kettering Medical Center in New York City, and then, trained as a fellow at the National Institutes of Health in Bethesda, MD.

Dr. Leist conducts translational, immunological, imaging, and outcomes research in multiple sclerosis and other autoimmune and infectious conditions of the central nervous system, and is involved in clinical trials at all stages of development. In addition, he serves on the editorial advisory board of *Practical Neurology* and is a reviewer for several journals including *Multiple Sclerosis*, *Annals of Neurology*, and *Journal of Neuroimmunology*.
